

OPHA SCHOOLING SHOW DIVISION CLASSES

Riders in these divisions are not eligible to enter any other class at this show. Three entries in a class are required for points to count. Consult OPHA Rule Book for additional regulations. Standing martingales permitted in all classes of these divisions. Only 6 entries to canter simultaneously in W/T/C divisions. Trophy and Six ribbons in each class. Division Championship Trophy & Ribbon, Ribbon
Use the enclosed Opening Day Entry blank to enter these classes. Stabling will be available to horses entered in only these classes for \$100 Thursday through Sunday. Entries for Opening Weekend classes close July 2, 2010—post entries after that date.

641	Division I—Carriage Driving - Drivers maneuver a horse and carriage through a series of obstacles and figures at the walk and trot. Drivers are judged on accuracy, posture and reinmanship.
642 TRAIL CLASS 643 EQUITATION	Division II—18 and Over - Open to riders who are over the age of 18 and are unable to compete in the Advanced or Walk, Trot Canter division. Riders can be at of any level.
644 TRAIL CLASS-Sec. A 645 EQUITATION-Sec. A 646 TRAIL CLASS-Sec. B 647 EQUITATION-Sec. B	Division III—Beginner - Riders typically have a leader and 1-2 sidewalkers providing physical and/or verbal assistance in order to perform circles, reverses, steering, halts, and transitions at a walk-only level. No two-point in this division.
648 TRAIL CLASS-Sec. A 649 EQUITATION-Sec. A 650 TRAIL CLASS-Sec. B 651 EQUITATION-Sec. B	Division IV—Novice - Riders typically have a leader and 0-1sidewalker providing verbal and or/physical assistance only. Riders are able to 1. Maintain physical position independently, 2. Execute steering challenges with verbal assistance only, 3. Sit the trot, posting not required, 4. Perform circles, reverses, halts and transitions with verbal assistance only. Sit the trot, posting not required. Perform circles, reverses, halts, two-points and transitions with verbal assistance only.

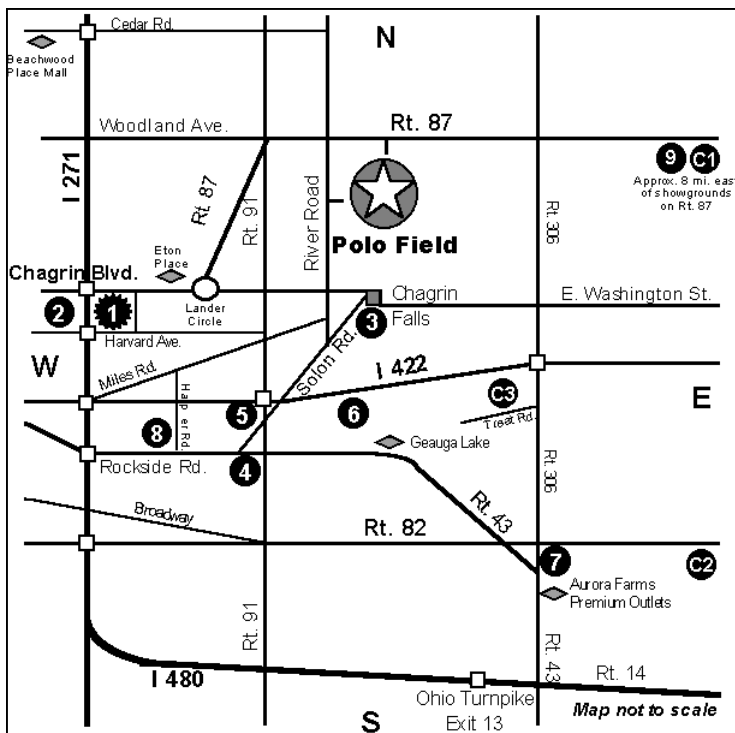

Riders are able to maintain correct position and seat throughout duration of class. Execute a posting trot, correct diagonal not required. Exhibit preparation to execute tasks and good control of horse. Perform all tasks with minimal assistance from leader for direction and control of mount. Perform smooth transitions including halt, walk and trot.
658 DRESSAGE 659 EQUITATION 660 GROUND POLE	Division VI—Advanced - Riders are independent with the optional use of spotters. Riders are able to maintain correct position and seat throughout duration of the class. Execute a posting trot, in rhythm and on correct diagonal. Able to correct diagonal if necessary. Perform all tasks independently. Perform smooth transitions between combinations including halt, walk and trot. Perform change of rein, circles and required patterns, if necessary. Perform two point position when necessary at both walk and trot.
661 DRESSAGE 662 EQUITATION 663 GROUND POLE	Division VII—Walk/Trot/Canter - Open to riders who meet the criteria of advanced with the addition of the canter in all.
